Lessons During Winter Weather

Here are some reminders about studio policies regarding lessons during winter months.

1. ONE lesson per calendar year that is missed due to inclement weather may be made up at the close of the academic term or during summer lessons. We will term these "snow days" but any weather situation that makes driving difficult or hazardous may fall under this heading.
2. Please remember that *no more than one snow day will be made up in any given year.*
3. All snow days must be made up no later than August 31 of each year.
4. This policy is in effect whether the lesson is cancelled by the student or by myself.
5. Though most of you live a considerable distance from the studio, many of you choose to attend lessons regardless of weather conditions. If you so choose, please remember that you can often change the lesson time slot, particularly if school has been cancelled or school hours have been adjusted. All you need do is ask! I will accommodate if/when I can.
6. Please: in snowy/icy conditions, do NOT drive all the way to my house. Park your car if possible before the street begins to slope downward toward the end of the cul-de-sac.
7. Please let me know of your plans (to attend the lesson or to cancel) **as soon as possible**. I need to be sure my driveway/sidewalk are cleared, plus I need to know which hours are committed to lessons and which hours are open slots to offer others.
8. Sometimes my street is plowed early, sometimes as one of the last ones to be cleared, and on occasion, not at all! You can call to ask about that. If I am not available by phone I will leave that information on my outgoing phone message.
9. Finally, in the event that it is necessary to miss more than one lesson due to weather/driving conditions, kindly remember that all students receive many extras from me throughout the year.
